KARMA - Set of natural universal laws of cause and effect that guide the evolution of the consciousness, operating as a basic evolutionary self-regulating mechanism of **energetic** and **cosmoethical** balance.

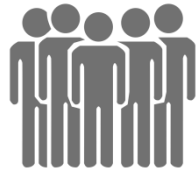
- ✓ Law that regulates **cosmoethical** the consciential evolution, as its bases on **Paralaw**;

- ✓ We can make the analogy with the **Universal Law of Gravitation**.



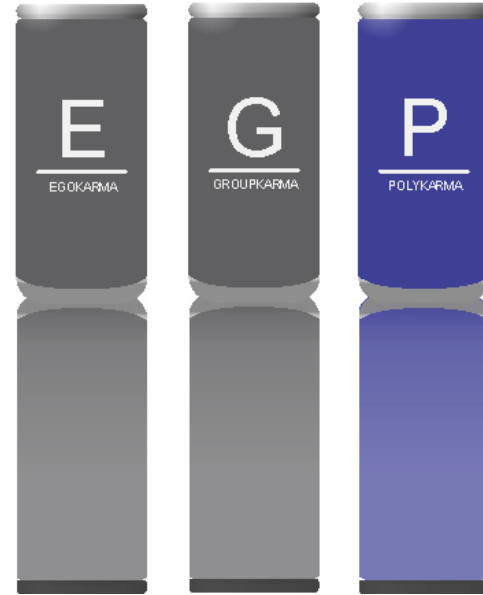
EGOKARMA: The principle of cause and effect active in the evolution of the consciousness, when centered exclusively on the ego itself.



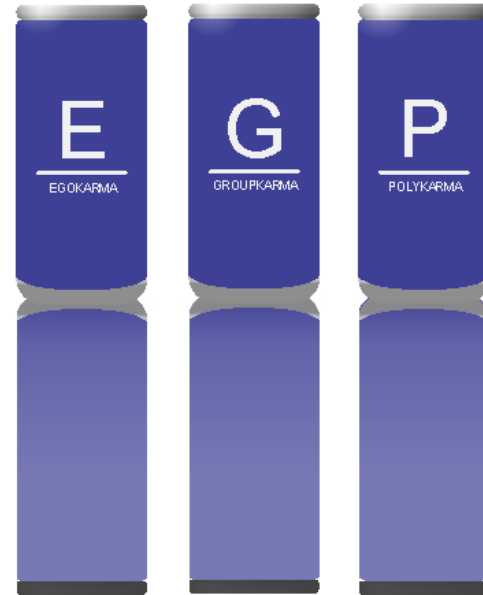
GROUPKARMA: The principle of cause and effect active in the evolution of the consciousness, when centered in the evolutionary group. The state of individual free will, when connected to the evolutionary group.



POLYKARMA: The principle of cause and effect, active in the evolution of the consciousness, when centered in the sense of and the experience of cosmic maxifraternity, beyond egokarma and groupkarma.



HOLOKARMA: The grouping of the three types of consciential actions and reactions – egokarma, groupkarma and polykarma – within the principles of cause and effect, that are active in the evolution of the consciousness.

Lives totally trapped, mutually, to the marginal's of evolution; only have absolute certainty; feels it has rights over everything that it claims.

Victimisation



Starts to have doubts about their choices; their efforts decay; goes from leader to victim of the "antisocial" machine that helped to established.

Recomposition



Ceases to be a direct victim, to assist their previous victims; mends the wreckages of their mismanagements; demands from the consciousness patience and persistence.

Liberation



Start to see a "light in the end of the tunnel"; great relief of pressure from intruders; liberation from egocentrism and higher sense of humanity; entering stage of polykarmality.
